



Here is how it works:



1. Go on the Postcrossing site: https://www.postcrossing.com/




2. Create an account




3. Confirm your email and send a postcard link so you can generate a receiver who you will send your postcard to.

- 5. Fill the gaps in with your the name of the receiver, your email and your own name
- 6. Put the card in an enveloppe, write the adress of the receiver on it.
- 7. Have it stamped for the country of the receiver and post it.


